



THE PIER






Tour description


The walk to the breakwater pier is an easy walk where you will come across some interesting cultural memories.


If you start from the central square, you follow the Vestfjordgata. After ca 600 metres, you arrive at the start of the Svinøya bridge and then you continue over the bridge. When you arrive at the end of the bridge, you will see Gallery Gunnar Berg in front of you.


Now you take a right on to Gunnar Bergsvei and after ca 75 metres, you follow the road that goes to the left and further out towards the statue of the Fisherman's Wife.

 Do not go on the pier in bad weather.

 45 min (one way) |  2,7 km (one way)

 Svolveær centre or Svinøya.

 Nearest bus stop is Circle K (petrol station).
From here, ca 800 metres to the where the walk starts.

 The Fisherman's Wife statue by Per Ung is placed at the end of the pier.
